## **Teaching-learning and Evaluation**

The student-centric teaching-learning methodology adopted by the Institution are:

- The institution admits students on basis of rules & regulations of State Government of Maharashtra and University of Mumbai.
- Seats are filled as per the reservation policy. Institution has Average 18 full time teachers on rolls, follows 16:1 STR.
- Sincere efforts are put to address the needs of slow learners, advanced learners and differently abled students. The learning levels of the students are identified. Concepts both fundamental and advanced are incorporated in the syllabus to suffice multiple levels of intelligence among the diverse student body.
- Academic-Calendar and Teaching-plans are strictly followed and are audited regularly by principal and management.
- 03 faculty are with Ph.D. qualification and one has passed NET Exam, a good number of faculty have an experience of more than 05 years. 85% of the faculty are women.
- Institution has brought several reforms in the examination system which comprises of continuous formative assessment and summative examinations conducted at the end of the semester. The system is fool-proof and transparent. Results are declared within 45 days from the date of last examination. The examination section is automated. The result displayed on students notice board and website. On an average, 80 % of students are graduated every year. Students provide feedback on all aspects of teaching-learning and corrective steps are taken wherever necessary.
- The institution adheres to the admission policy of the government ensuring transparency, inclusivity, and equity. Government norms are followed and seats are reserved for SC, ST, OBC, Divyangjan, and minorities. The average demand ratio of applications is 1: 1.and the teacher-student ratio is 1:16.
- The average percentage of exam-related grievances is 0.10%.
- Outcome Based Education pattern is followed with a focus on the measurement of student performance through Programme and courses outcomes.
- The pass percentage for the 2022-2023 graduating batch is 95.74%.
